#### PE in Year 6

6SI: Wednesday and Thursday (NUFC coach) 6SM: Wednesday and Thursday (NUFC coach)

On PE days, children are to COME TO SCHOOL wearing their PE kit: yellow t-shirt, black jogging pants/shorts & trainers. Ensure all jewellery is removed on that day. Staff are unable to remove this and it will prevent your child from doing PE.

Year 6 children will go swimming in spring term. Please ensure your child comes equipped with an **appropriate** swimming costume & towel on those days, which you will be informed about later in the year. There is no time for hair washing so shampoo is not required.

# <u>Uniform</u>

## Please ensure that your child follows the school uniform requirements:

Boys: plain grey/black trousers, white polo shirt, grey pullover or school sweatshirt. Flat black trainers or school shoes. Cirls: grey skirt or grey/black trousers, white polo shirt, grey cardigan or school sweatshirt, flat black trainers or school shoes. There is also a summer dress in yellow.

Leggings, jewellery, make up and false nails are strictly prohibited.

Please ensure your child brings a water bottle to school each day. They will take it home daily.

### Homework and Reading:

Reading is of high priority to us in KS2 and each child will be supplied with an individual reading book tailored to their level, which they will bring home and back on a daily basis. We request that children read a *minimum of three times a week* but have found that children who read a little each night are the ones who make the most progress.

From week 2, children will receive weekly spellings on a Monday to be practised and returned by the Friday. School does not send out weekly homework although the occasional task may be sent home. This is to ensure the practise of reading and spelling is prioritised. Year 6 children are also expected to go on their Reading Plus, Spelling Shed and Maths online challenges at home too.

- \*If you need support with online access, please inform us and we can support you by loaning school's Chromebooks.

#### Year 6 SATs

All Year 6 children are required to sit statutory assessments in reading and maths from Monday II<sup>th</sup> May — Thursday II+\*May 2026. Writing is teacher assessed via evidence collected throughout the year. It is vital that children *are not* taken out of school at this time and must attend school every day that week.
