- Preparing and cooking ingredients to make soup.

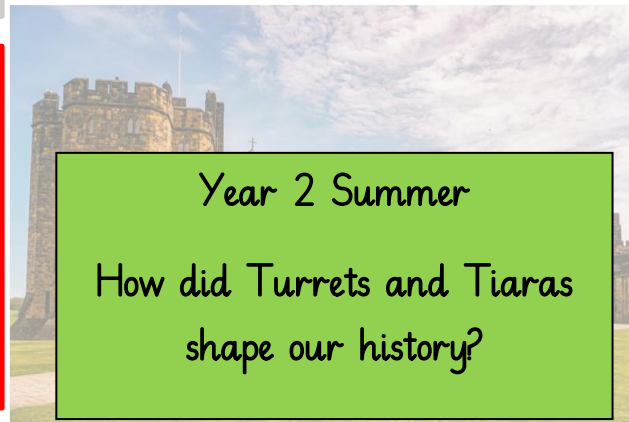
Careers: Designer, cook, artist.
