Year 1: 7 stories

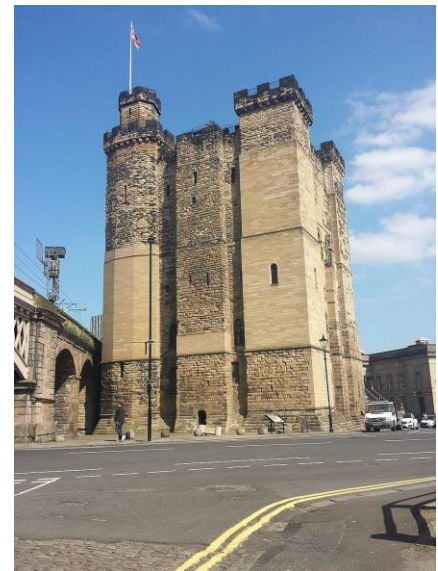
